Uniform Policy



We have a simple uniform and require all children to wear it every day. We believe that wearing a uniform helps to encourage a positive attitude towards school and ensure that all pupils are dressed suitably for School activities.

Jeans, leggings, tracksuit bottoms or hoodies are not be worn to school. All pupils should wear sensible black school shoes. Trainers, boots or wellingtons are not to be worn in school. All children should wear a coat in cold weather and bring a hat with them in the summer.

For Health and Safety reasons no chains, necklaces or bracelets should be worn to School.

False nails, nail varnish, make-up or temporary wash off tattoos must never be worn to school. Dying hair is not allowed (including eyebrows).

Please mark all items of clothing with your child's name.

Girls: Navy/Grey skirt / pinafore dress or trousers (strictly no jeans or leggings).
Navy jog pants - Nursery and Reception only
Navy sweatshirt or navy cardigan/jumper
Plain white shirt/blouse, or white polo shirt
White socks or navy tights
Blue and white stripe / check dresses may be worn in the summer
Black flat sensible school shoes - These must have a lace or strap that the children can do up themselves
Black or navy coat
Plain navy hat /cap
All hair accessories including hijab should be plain navy or white

Boys: Grey or navy trousers / shorts
Navy jog pants - Nursery and Reception only
Navy sweatshirt / jumper
Plain white shirt or white polo shirt
Grey, navy or black socks
Black sensible school shoes that the children can do up themselves
Black or navy coat
Plain navy hat /cap
Boys' hair must be cut in a style suitable for school

P.E. Kit:
Navy or black shorts
House T-shirt
Black or White trainers / plimsolls only
Track suit / sweatshirt may be worn in the winter months

School sweatshirts, cardigans, book bags, PE bags etc., can be purchased from Uniform4Kids (see attached)
Plain navy caps are available to order from the School office.

We expect all parents and children to uphold our school aims and values and to abide by the school rules.

Where children do not comply with our School Uniform Policy we reserve the right to not allow them to take part in events where they are representing the school, such as trips, displays and public performances.
