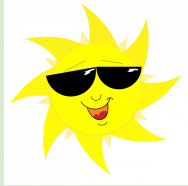

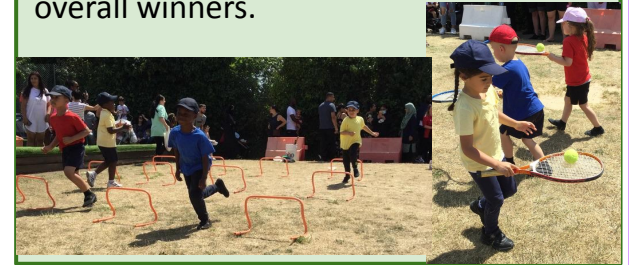

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## Learning at Eastfield

### Year 1



This week children have started their very first Write Stuff Unit based on Little Red Riding Hood. As part of their learning children re-enacted her journey through the forest.

Year 4 - This week, we have enjoyed learning more about teeth and digestion. We have been testing the effects of different drinks on tooth decay. Egg shell is very similar to our tooth enamel so we decided to submerge eggs in different liquids and observe the changes over time. We will keep you posted with our results...

Year 2 - Over the last couple of weeks, we have been learning about measures! We have explored using centimetres and metres to measure length and height. We are now measuring mass using balance scales, grams and kilograms!



Year 3 - Last Friday, we went on a trip to the Natural History Museum in Tring. We had a fantastic time learning all about fossils. There were so many different species of animals for us to see and learn about. We took part in a fossil workshop and had the chance to draw our favourite animals!

Adams - Over the last two weeks we have been learning about information texts. We have created Popplets to note down our key words and then use them to write factual sentences.

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
