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Reminder for Place2Talk

Place2Talk at Eastfield Primary

Place2Talk will continue for pupils at Eastfield Primary next school year. Year 2 parents will receive a letter to introduce the service. Place2Talk is one aspect of the Place2Be service and it is a lunchtime drop-in service open to all children in Years 2 to 6 on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Here, children can make an appointment to spend 15 minutes with the School Project Manager (Emily) to

talk about friendships, concerns or any worries they may have. This is a very popular service and children can attend by themselves or with friends. The school and Place2Be assumes that all children have their parent/carers' permission to come to Place2Talk at lunchtime. If you would like to find out more about the service, please

Parent Elklan training

We are very excited to announce that we are starting our new cohort of Parent Elklan training, **Let's talk with 5-11's**, in September 2022. This practical course is designed for parents and carers. Written by speech and language therapists these seven 1.5 hour sessions will enable parents to learn how to develop their child's understanding and talking. Parent's attending the course will have access to the course workbook which is full of strategies and activities that can be used with their child at home and at school.

These will all be face to face sessions held at the Enfield Civic Centre, from **10am-11:30am** on the following dates:
